Enroll in the International Diploma Course in Resilient Health Care Management. The purpose of course is to teach how Resilient Health Care can be applied to the management of health care systems as a support to Resilient Health Care in the practical clinical work.

The course is provided by the School of Health and Welfare at Jönköping University in Sweden in collaboration with the International Society for Quality in Healthcare (ISQua) and supported by Macquarie University, Sydney, Australia. Lead faculty is Jeffrey Braithwaite, Erik Hollnagel, and Axel Ros.

The course is blended multimodal learning with residential sessions, webinars and self-directed and reflective learning. The teaching is conducted in English.

Professionals in health care with managerial responsibilities, either corporate or clinical, are invited to enroll. This would include department and clinical team leads, risk managers, medical directors, quality managers, organizational developers, patient advocates, etc.
